The 1st place winners in each category, Grand Prize, People's Choice and all Premier Showcase entries will be available for bid during the Live Auction. All other dessert entries will be offered for bid during the in-person Silent Dessert Auction. Our Online Auction will feature a number of non-dessert items and culinary experiences.

For Entrants

Who can enter and how are they judged?

The **Open Contest** is for anyone who wants a chocolate challenge or to share a tried and true favorite in support of PPAU. Categories include Cakes, Chocolates, Cookies, Brownies, and Potpourri. Open Contest entries are judged and the top two are selected in each category.

Youth/Families (entrants under 16 working solo or with a parent or friend) are judged separately from the Open groups, with the top two entries awarded prizes. Youth under 16, whether team or solo, may also enter their dessert in one of the Open categories – they are not required to enter the Youth/Families group.

Judges consider taste, texture, appearance/presentation, and creative use of chocolate in selecting the award-winning entries.

The **Premier Showcase** was introduced in 2020, transforming the "professional" category into a new festival feature where pastry chefs, chocolatiers, restauranteurs, caterers, community groups, or any supportive business can show off their creative chocolate talents as well as their business, cause or theme. These entries will be eligible for their own People's Choice award but will not be judged by the judges. See additional details about the Premier Showcase at **www.thechocolatefest.com**

How should I prepare my entry?

More tips and information are available in the FAQs on our website.

There are two parts to a Chocolate Festival entry:

- 1. AUCTION ITEM. Presentation counts in the judging so knock yourself out to make the auction item look attractive! Peek at some past entries on our website, Facebook and Instagram sites. For any category, be creative and have fun! For the auction item, provide a quantity that makes sense for your recipe or would be a nice amount for the winning bidder to take home.
- 2. TASTING SAMPLES. Most of the experience of the Chocolate Festival is tasting by judges and attendees so we ask entrants to provide lots of samples of their entry. These do not need to be beautiful, but some people come up with creative ways of making them attractive. It's most important that they be easy to serve. It helps our set-up crew greatly if you cut your tasting entry into bite-sized samples before delivering it to the venue.

For quantity, keep in mind that about 500 people attend the Chocolate Festival. The more people who taste your entry, the more chances you will have to get People's Choice votes!

Some Final Important Rules

Desserts requiring refrigeration or containing raw eggs cannot be accepted. Be sure that your entry can tolerate a warm environment from the time that you deliver it until at least 9 p.m.
